Rubric Criteria	
Task 1 (20%)	The plugin allows for descending arpeggiation. It works correctly regardless of how many notes are pressed simultaneously. The GUI makes it easy for the user to enable this feature.
Task 2 (20%)	The plugin allows for octave arpeggiation. The user is able to select the number of octaves. Arpeggiation spans the right number of octaves. The GUI makes it easy for the user to enable this feature.
Task 3 (20%)	The plugin allows for other modes of arpeggiation. At least two examples, such as the ones mentioned in the assignment description, are implemented correctly. The GUI presents these options in an intuitive fashion.
Task 4 (20%)	The plugin allows for different durations for arpeg- giated notes and implements the arpeggiation cor- rectly. The GUI must allow the user to select a reasonable number of patterns for variable note duration.
Combination (10%)	The plugin allows the user to combine some of the above types of arpeggiation, e.g. descending arpeggiation for multiple octaves. It is not neces- sary to implement all possible combinations, but a good number of them is required for full marks.
Presentation (10%)	Is the layout of the GUI intuitive? Is it easy for the user to find the feature they are looking for? Does the plugin look professional in terms of matching fonts, centered elements, no typos etc. ?
